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
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HOLIDAY TURKEYS!

Submit your turkey pre-orders at this time, DUE Wednesday August 16th, 2017 by 5pm. **ALL PRE-ORDERS MUST BE PLACED VIA AGENCY EXPRESS.** Orders submitted in any other form WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Your agency must be ACTIVE in order for the pre-order to be accepted.



Please be advised we may only be able to provide a fraction of your need and will only be providing for the Thanksgiving holiday. We will compare your turkey request to your July monthly report numbers and will scale back any numbers as necessary based on client reports. The price for turkeys will be \$0.35/lbs. We will confirm via email the receipt of your order and the number of turkey's allocated for your account once they have arrived at the Food Bank. Requirements for Retail Route

- Be open twice per month.
- Serve 50 families per month.
- Be in good standing with all departments at the San Antonio Food Bank.
- Must take at least 1 bin of items per delivery and distribute or store items safely until distribution. NO "SHOPPING" OFF THE TRUCK.
- Be available from 10-2pm for delivery.
- Use intake forms to determine client eligibility and submit monthly report by 5th of the month.
